

Practical Tips for Packing Items When Moving

Porcelain and Glassware: Use bubble wrap, packing paper, and small sturdy boxes. Wrap each item individually, line the bottom with soft materials, fill gaps with paper, and avoid overloading boxes.

Silverware: Pack with soft cloth or anti-tarnish paper in small boxes or padded pouches. Wrap each piece separately, store in pouches, and prevent scratching.

Figurines & Souvenirs: Use bubble wrap, fabric, foam, and boxes with dividers. Protect protruding or delicate parts, and transport valuable pieces separately.

Large Appliances: Use bubble wrap, strong tape, and original or reinforced packaging. Drain liquids, secure doors and removable parts, and store cables separately.

Small Appliances: Wrap securely with bubble wrap or fabric in sturdy boxes. Place cords and accessories in labeled bags.

Bedding: Keep items dry in vacuum bags or large bags. Use vacuum bags to save space.

Clothing: Pack in suitcases, vacuum bags, or garment covers. Keep dry, hang on garment racks or pack flat.

Photos & Documents: Store in folders and polyethylene within small boxes. Keep dry, store flat, and label boxes clearly.

Tools: Wrap sharp edges with fabric or bubble wrap and use sturdy crates. Remove batteries from power tools.

Outdoor Equipment: Disassemble large items, protect sharp edges, and use bubble wrap or fabric.

Food: Pack in paper or polyethylene within medium boxes. Separate fragile food items and use cooler bags for perishables.

Books: Use paper fillers in small boxes. Avoid heavy loads and place books spine-side down.

Electronics: Pack in bubble wrap and anti-static bags inside original boxes. Pack cables separately, label them, and avoid stacking heavy items on top.

Paintings & Mirrors: Protect with bubble wrap and cardboard corner protectors, stored in upright boxes. Always transport vertically.

Jewelry & Valuables: Wrap in soft cloth and store in small boxes or safes. Transport personally and avoid packing in bulk.

Sports Equipment: Disassemble when possible, wrap in fabric or bubble wrap, and use special cases. Secure moving parts.

Toys & Kids' Items: Store in bags, fabric, containers, or boxes. Keep small parts in separate bags and vacuum-pack soft toys.
